- A short (4 page maximum) typed statement of your educational and career goals and interests, and how they relate to fields of science and engineering related to NASA's mission. Within your statement, discuss your thesis research area and how it relates to NASA's mission. Discuss any past, present, and planned future involvement with NASA. Discuss any publications; also discuss honors or awards you may have received.
- Arrange to have at least one letter of recommendation (preferably from your graduate research advisor) sent directly to the Consortium office by April 1, 2010. Within the recommendation, the advisor should specifically address the following points:
 - (1) The reason this student is not being supported through a Graduate Research Assistantship.
 - (2) Has this student applied for student support through NASA's Graduate Student Researchers Program (GSRP) or the NASA Earth and Space Science Fellowship Program (NESSF)? If "yes", describe the status of the GSRP or NESSF proposal; if "no", explain why not.
