**Participants receive a \$200 stipend and certificate.**

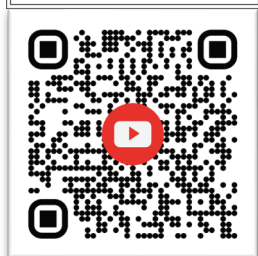
